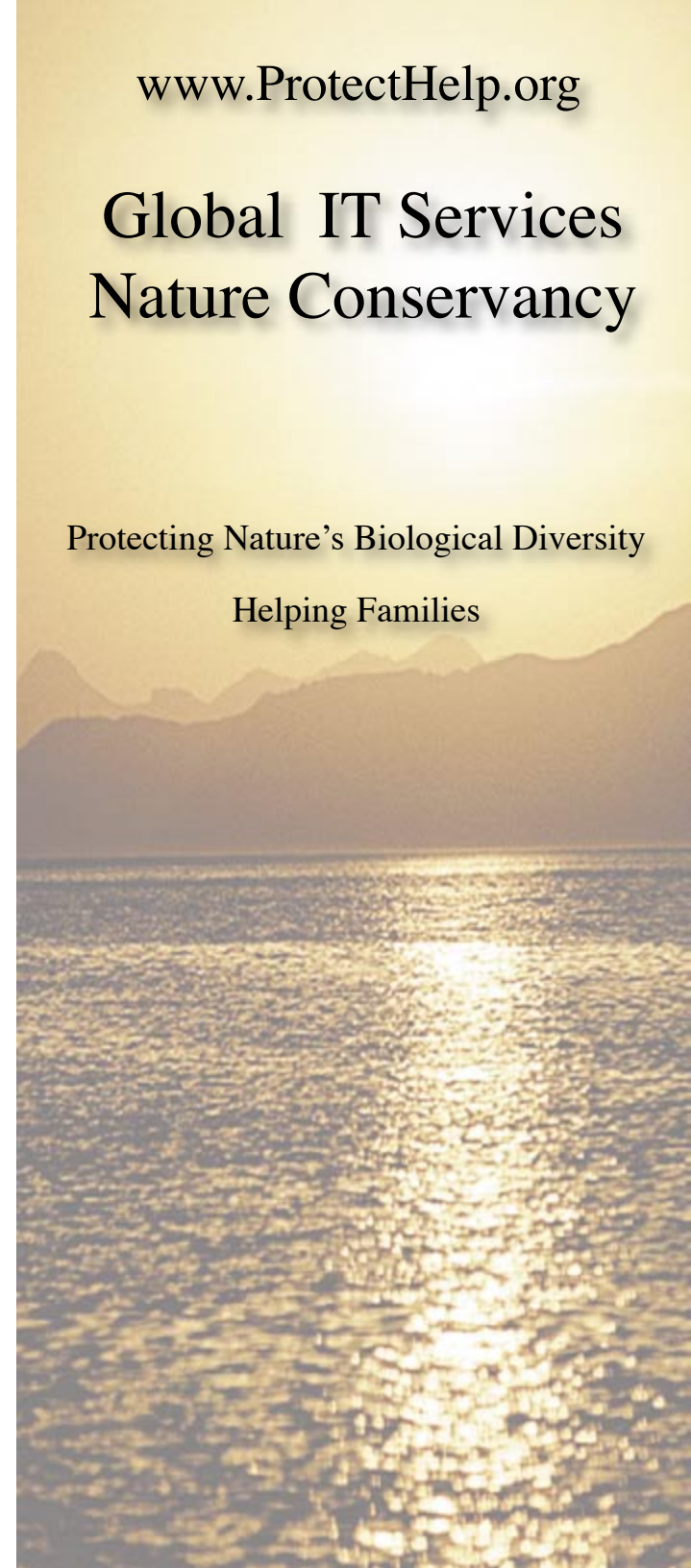

The goal of Global IT Services - Nature Conservancy is to use the best available conservation science to protect areas of essential biological diversity. This commitment has won the respect of our many partners in government and the private sector, as well as foundations, individuals, and other conservation organizations.

As pressures increase on ecologically significant lands, Global IT Services - Nature Conservancy is turning to larger, landscape-scale projects. This requires us to understand nature's diversity well enough to compare sites against standard tests of significance and achieve scientific consensus on which ones deserve our best conservation efforts.

The scientific challenge is to portray the full diversity of a landscape's indigenous species and their sustaining ecosystems. We select and care for sites that best conserve that diversity. Decision making requires the use of rigorous ecological measures. Our criteria must be acceptable to the community of conservation scientists.



Global IT Services - Nature Conservancy's standards incorporate rankings that Conservation Data Centers have assigned to species, habitats, and ecosystems across America and the rest of the world.

The Earth's biological diversity is being lost at a rate that impoverishes our quality of life and threatens our future.

Our work is guided by the belief that our society will be judged by what it creates in the present and what it conserves for the future. Wherever we work across America, or around the world, we share and apply values that reflect this philosophy.

How Global IT Services Nature Conservancy's Families Relief Fund Program Fights Hunger

Operations aim to:

- Save lives in refugee crises and other emergencies
- Improve nutrition and quality of life of world's most vulnerable people at critical times in their lives
- Enable development by (a) helping people build assets that benefit them directly; (b) promoting the self-reliance of poor people and communities.

In efforts to relieve human suffering we combat hunger, deprivation and physical affliction with the provision of food, clothing, shelter, medical care, and other basic necessities of life.

We also help facilitate the development of healthy, vibrant, and self-sustaining communities by addressing larger issues of education, food security, potable water, employment, community health, and disaster mitigation projects.
